NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT

**Amendment to the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP)
and Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)**

The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) is applying for Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) funding under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) to implement bus rapid transit and related improvements along Sahara Avenue in Clark County and the City of Las Vegas.

The RTC is proposing to amend the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) for 2009-2030 and the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for 2009-2012 to support this application. The proposed amendment will add funding under the ARRA of 2009 for the implementation of bus rapid transit in side-running bus lanes along Sahara Avenue between Hualapai Way and Richfield Boulevard and between Joe W. Brown Drive and Boulder Highway, as well as related improvements along the entire route between Red Rock Station and the east side of the Las Vegas Valley.
