

# Sahara Express Bus Rapid Transit Improvement Project



## SPECIAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATE

The Sahara Express BRT project is progressing and multiple milestones are taking place on the project. Over the next several weeks construction crews will continue to work on the removal and installation of shelters, utility work, landscaping, traffic signal upgrades, and final striping. The following work is planned\*:

**When:** Sunday, November 20 – Friday, December 2, 2011  
Daytime hours: 8 a.m. - 7 p.m. / Night hours: 9 p.m. - 5 a.m.

**Where:** *Sahara Avenue from Boulder Highway to Hualapai Way*

**What:** *Permanent shelter & bench installations* will take place on Sahara Avenue between Las Vegas Boulevard and Decatur Boulevard and is anticipated to be complete by the end of November. New permanent shelters will begin being installed between Decatur Boulevard and Rainbow Boulevard on December 2. All shelter installations are planned during daytime hours.

*Utility work* from Durango Drive to Hualapai Way will take place during daytime hours from November 20-23 and November 28 – December 2. Other utility work in the project area will be done overnight. Utility work will continue through the end of December.

*Paving* of asphalt was completed Tuesday, November 15. *Striping* of the top layer of asphalt will take place during daytime hours throughout the project area and is expected to be complete by the end of November.

*Traffic signal upgrades* will take place during overnight hours. Traffic lights will be off from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. and traffic will be directed by Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department. Specific dates and locations will be included in a separate email.

\* In observance of the Thanksgiving holiday, construction will not occur starting at 9 p.m. Wednesday, November 23 - 9 p.m. Sunday, November 27
