

# Sahara Express Bus Rapid Transit Improvement Project



## SPECIAL PROJECT UPDATE

Over the next several weeks, multiple construction milestones will be taking place on the Sahara Express BRT project along Sahara Avenue. As the project progresses, permanent bus shelters and benches will continue to be installed, roadway milling, paving, and restriping will continue, and traffic signal upgrades will occur. The following work will take place\*:

**When:** Friday, November 4 – Thursday, November 17, 2011

**Where:** Sahara Avenue from Boulder Highway to Hualapai Way:

**What:** *Permanent shelter & bench installations* will begin in the area located between Rancho Drive and Decatur Boulevard and are anticipated to be complete in several weeks.

*Roadway milling, paving, and restriping* is in its final stages. This work will take place between Rainbow Boulevard and Durango Drive over the next two weeks, and on Monday, November 7 in the area between Hualapai Way and Durango Drive. Because weather and temperatures impact paving conditions, the remaining project paving activities will move from overnight work to daytime hours of 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Daytime paving will have temporary traffic impacts and there may be significant delays.

*Traffic signal upgrades* will take place on Sahara Avenue at the following intersections (dates are subject to change):

**Sahara Ave. & 6<sup>th</sup> St.** - Sunday, November 6

**Sahara Ave. & Richfield Blvd.** - Monday, November 7

**Sahara Ave. at Spanish Oaks Dr. & Rye St.** - Wednesday, November 8

**Sahara Ave. & Torrey Pines Dr.** - Thursday, November 9

**Sahara Ave. & Paradise Rd.** - Sunday, November 13

**Sahara Ave. & I-15 Northbound On and Off Ramps** –  
Monday, November 14

**Sahara Ave. & Rancho Dr.** - Tuesday, November 15

**Sahara Ave. & Palace Station** - Wednesday, November 16

**Sahara Ave. at Paseo Del Prado and Teddy Dr.** - Thursday, November 17

Work will take place during the overnight hours. Traffic lights will be off from 9 p.m. - 5 a.m. and Las Vegas Metropolitan Police will be directing traffic.
