

Sahara Express Bus Rapid Transit Improvement Project



SPECIAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATE

The Sahara Express BRT project is progressing and multiple milestones are taking place on the project. Over the next several weeks construction crews will continue to work on the removal and installation of shelters, utility work, landscaping, traffic signal upgrades, and final striping. The following work is planned:

When: Sunday, December 4, 2011 - Friday, December 16, 2011
Daytime hours: 8 a.m. - 7 p.m. / Night hours: 9 p.m. - 5 a.m.

Where: *Sahara Avenue from Boulder Highway to Hualapai Way*

What: *Permanent shelter & bench installations* will take place on Sahara Avenue between Las Vegas Boulevard and Durango Drive and is anticipated to be complete by the end of December. All shelter installations are planned during daytime hours.

Utility work and landscape improvements will continue between Decatur Blvd. and Hualapai Way and are anticipated to be complete by the end of December. All utility work in the project area will be done overnight.

Striping of the top layer of asphalt will take place during daytime hours throughout the project area and is expected to be complete by the end of November.

Traffic signal upgrades will take place during overnight hours. Traffic lights will be off from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. and traffic will be directed by Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department. Specific dates and locations will be included in a separate email.
