RTC to provide increased transit service to Boulder City on Art in the Park weekend

LAS VEGAS – Attendees of Art in the Park in Boulder City on Saturday, Oct. 3 and Sunday, Oct. 4 can avoid traffic congestion and have an easy and affordable option for traveling to the event. The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) provides transit service to and from Boulder City via Route 402 (Crosstown Connector / Boulder City) and a convenient park and ride option is available.

Transit service will be increased on Route 402 on those days to approximately every 15 minutes between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. The regular transit fare is \$1.75 one-way or \$4 for a 24-hour residential pass. Reduced fares are available for qualified passengers. Fares may be purchased on board the vehicle. For more information, please call RTC Customer Service at **228-RIDE** or visit www.rtcnv.com.

Riders can park at the Sunset Station Hotel and Casino for free. Passengers may board buses on Sunset Road, just east of Stephanie Street and near the driveway into Sunset Station. The transit stop in Boulder City is approximately one block walking distance to the event. On return trips, passengers will be dropped off at the RTC bus stop on Sunset Road, near the Galleria Mall.
