SAHARA AVENUE RAPID TRANSIT PROJECT

The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) is developing an improved 12-mile rapid transit line along Sahara Avenue.

The project will include side-running dedicated transit lanes from approximately Hualapai Way to Richfield Boulevard and from Paradise Road to Boulder Highway. Improvements will include enhanced passenger shelters, public art, ticket vending machines, upgraded pedestrian ramps, sidewalks, and landscaping at select locations. Funding for this project is provided through the Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) program as part of the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act (ARRA).
