RTC hosting transportation fairs

Will provide information on local transit options, including new ACE Rapid Transit Service

The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) will be holding transportation fairs at two of the valley's shopping malls over the next few weeks to share information about the transit options available in Southern Nevada, including the new ACE Rapid Transit service.

The first ACE rapid transit line, the ACE Gold line, will link Downtown Las Vegas with the Las Vegas Convention Center and the Las Vegas Strip. ACEExpress service will provide fast, limited-stop service from the Centennial Hills area to Downtown with continuing service to the Strip and to UNLV. Both ACE and ACEExpress will debut in March.

RTC staff will be on hand to answer questions about the new ACE and ACEExpress services. Information about additional RTC transit services will also be available at the fairs. The upcoming transportation fairs include:

WHERE: Boulevard Mall, 3528 S. Maryland Parkway, at Brookstone Court

WHEN: Saturday, March 6, from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.
WHERE: Meadows Mall, 4300 Meadows Lane, at Sears Court
