Free cycling clinics to be held at the RTC Bike Center *Kids invited to learn how to ride a two-wheel bicycle this Saturday*

LAS VEGAS - The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) will host a free cycling clinic for children ages five and older to teach them how to leave behind their training wheels and ride a two-wheel bicycle.
