RTC transit service schedule during 2011 UNLV football season

LAS VEGAS – The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) announces that transit routes 601 and 602 will again provide transit service to Sam Boyd Stadium during the upcoming University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) football season.

Fans attending the UNLV football games are encouraged to use transit to and from the stadium. Service will be provided as follows:

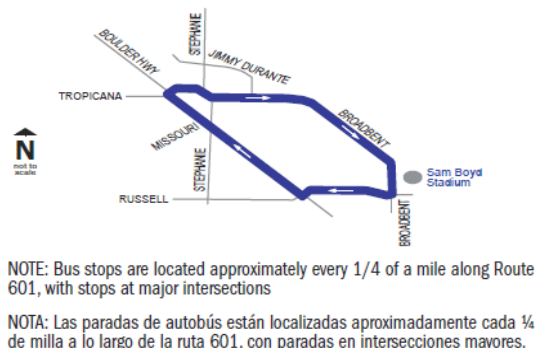
Route 602 provides express service from the Las Vegas Strip and the UNLV Main Campus area to Sam Boyd Stadium, with departures approximately every 20 minutes. Those traveling from the Las Vegas Strip can take Route 602 at the transit stop located at East Tropicana Avenue and Las Vegas Boulevard (adjacent to the Tropicana Hotel).

Route 601 provides continuous "loop" service, approximately every 20 minutes, from Tropicana Avenue east of Boulder Highway to Sam Boyd Stadium.

It is recommended that riders purchase a 24-hour pass for \$5 to cover their complete round trip. Visitors also planning to utilize the Deuce on The Strip or the Strip & Downtown Express (SDX) are encouraged to purchase a \$7 All-Access 24-hour pass.
