RTC will again offer free transit service on New Year's Eve *Residents encouraged to park and ride transit to New Year's celebrations*

LAS VEGAS – As in past years, the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) will again offer free transit rides for the New Year's Eve holiday, from 6 p.m. on New Year's Eve, Saturday, Dec. 31 until 9 a.m. on New Year's Day, Sunday, Jan. 1.

The RTC encourages everyone to celebrate responsibly by taking advantage of the free transit service as they ring in the New Year.

Free rides on New Year's Eve apply to all RTC transit routes throughout the Las Vegas Valley, including the Strip & Downtown Express, Centennial Express, Westcliff Airport Express and the new Boulder Highway Express and Henderson & Downtown Express services.

The RTC has three park and ride lots across the valley where residents can park for free year-round:

- Centennial Hills Transit Center and Park & Ride – located at 7313 Grand Montecito Parkway in the northwest part of the valley, near the US 95 and Durango Drive interchange has 400 parking spaces and is served by the Centennial Express.
- Westcliff Transit Center and Park & Ride – located at Durango Drive and Summerlin Parkway, has 140 parking spaces and is serviced by the Westcliff Airport Express.
- South Strip Transfer Terminal (SSTT) – located at 6675 S. Giles St. at the corner of Sunset Road and Giles Street, has 250 parking spaces and is serviced by multiple RTC transit routes.

In addition, the RTC partnered with local businesses to offer additional park and ride lots where they can park their vehicles and board express transit services:

- Eldorado Casino, 140 Water Street, Henderson, Nev., has 29 spaces and is serviced by the Henderson & Downtown Express.
- Eastside Cannery Casino, 5255 Boulder Highway, Henderson, Nev., has 14 spaces and is serviced by the Boulder Highway Express.
- College of Southern Nevada, Henderson Campus, 700 College Drive, Henderson, Nev., has four spaces and is serviced by the Henderson & Downtown Express.
- Suncoast Hotel and Casino, 9090 Alta Drive, Las Vegas, Nev., has more than 100 spaces and is serviced by the Westcliff Airport Express.

On New Year's Eve, many routes on and around the Las Vegas Strip, including the Strip & Downtown Express and the Deuce on the Strip double-deck services, will be detoured due to street closures on Las Vegas Boulevard. RTC Express services will take riders from respective park and ride lots to the Bonneville Transit Center in downtown Las Vegas where riders can then transfer to a revised Deuce on the Strip and Strip & Downtown Express routes to access festivities on the Strip.

Riders should also note that in observation of the New Year's Day holiday on Monday, January 2, transit service will operate on a Sunday schedule. The Sunday schedule will be implemented due to traditionally lower ridership and less traffic on this day.
