Avoid parking lot traffic at the mall -- take transit to do holiday shopping *RTC offers easy and convenient transportation to local shopping malls*

LAS VEGAS – As the holiday shopping season nears, the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) reminds residents that they can avoid the hassles of waiting for a parking space at local malls by taking transit.

Many shoppers can park at a local park & ride lot and then take an express route, such as the Centennial Express, the Westcliff Airport Express or the new Boulder Highway Express and Henderson & Downtown Express to one of Las Vegas' many shopping malls.

“Taking transit to do your holiday shopping removes one of the traditional stressors associated with holiday shopping,” said Jacob Snow, general manager of the RTC. “With RTC transit, shoppers can leave their cars parked near their home and ride transit to their favorite mall. Holiday shoppers can now avoid the headaches of driving in circles to find a parking spot,” said Snow.

The RTC Transit routes serve the many shopping malls in Las Vegas include:

- Las Vegas Premium Outlets North - Routes 105, 206, 207, Centennial Express, Westcliff Airport Express, Henderson & Downtown Express, Strip & Downtown Express
- Las Vegas Premium Outlets South - Routes 117, 217, Strip & Downtown Express
- Fashion Show Mall - Routes 119, 203, Centennial Express, Strip & Downtown Express, The Deuce on the Strip
- Town Square - Routes 104, 117, Strip & Downtown Express, (The Deuce on the Strip overnight hours only)
- Meadows Mall - Routes 104, 207, (208 on weekends only)
- Galleria Mall - Routes 115, 212, 402, Boulder Highway Express
- Boulevard Mall - Routes 109, 203
- Boca Park Fashion Village / Tivoli Village - Route 206, Westcliff Airport Express

Shoppers can also utilize various RTC park & rides including the Centennial Hills Transit Center Park & Ride, Westcliff Transit Center Park & Ride and the South Strip Transfer Terminal. In addition, the RTC partnered with local businesses to offer additional park & ride lots where they can park their vehicles and board express transit services.

- Eldorado Casino, 140 Water Street, Henderson, Nev., 89015. It has 29 spaces and is serviced by the Henderson & Downtown Express.
- Eastside Cannery Casino, 5255 Boulder Highway, Henderson, Nev., 89122. This lot offers 14 spaces and is serviced by the Boulder Highway Express.
- College of Southern Nevada, Henderson Campus, 700 College Drive, Henderson, Nev., 89002. This lot offers four spaces and is serviced by the Henderson & Downtown Express.

During the upcoming Thanksgiving holiday, the RTC will operate its transit system on a Sunday schedule for the Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, Nov. 24 and on a Saturday schedule on Family Day, the day after Thanksgiving Day, Friday, Nov. 25, which is also traditionally one of the busiest shopping days.
