[Ridethestrip.com](http://Ridethestrip.com) features RTC transit information on how to get to and from McCarran International Airport, the Las Vegas Strip and downtown Las Vegas. Visitors can use the new website to help plan their transportation to and from their destinations. They can also purchase a 3-Day All Access Pass for \$20 online, before they depart to Las Vegas. The transit services highlighted on the new site include:

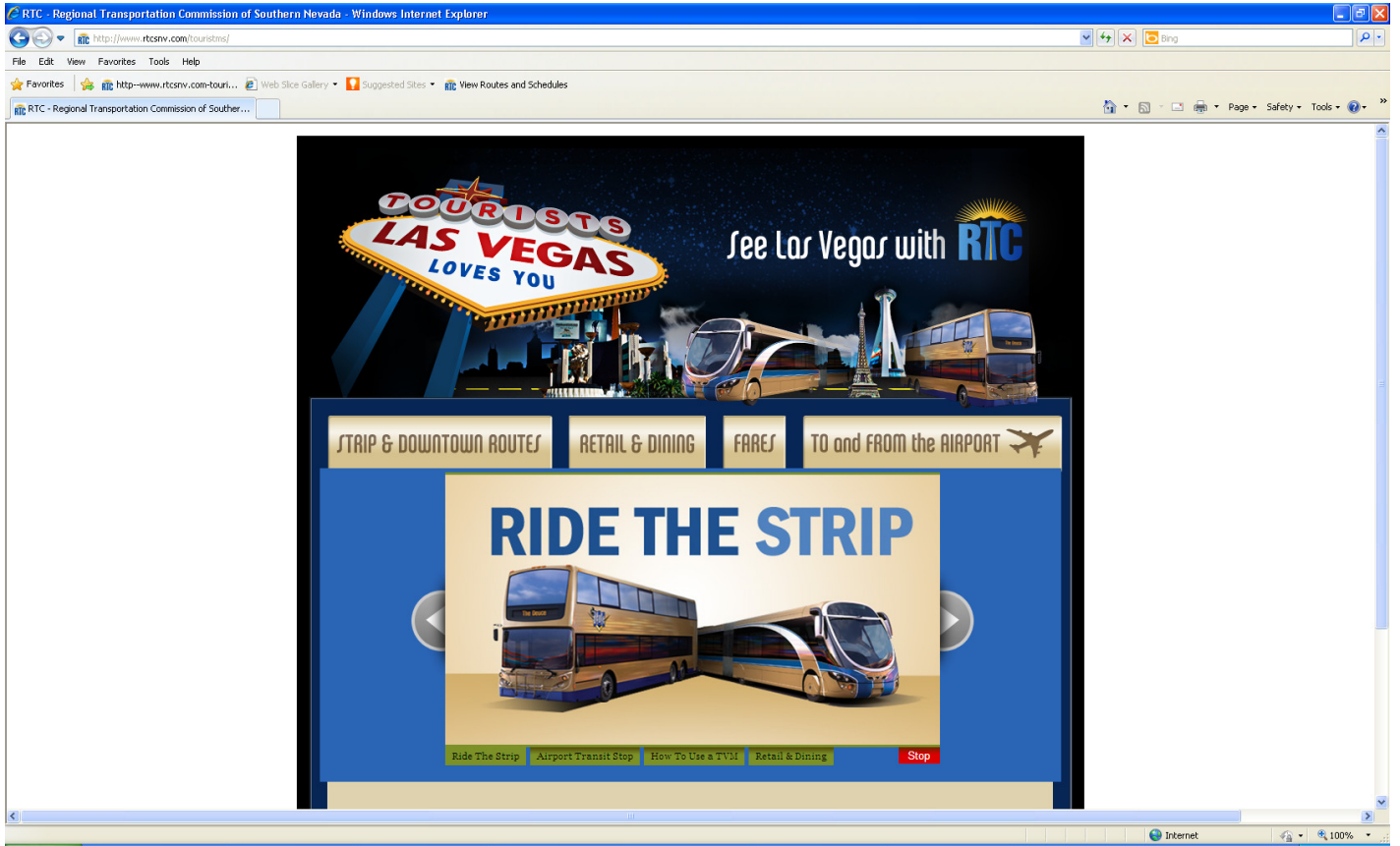
- The Deuce on the Strip - a unique and fun option that allows travelers to experience the glitz and glamour of Las Vegas utilizing enclosed double-deck vehicles to transport tourists providing an iconic view of the Strip and Downtown Las Vegas. With numerous stops along the Las Vegas Strip, the Deuce minimizes the walking distance between destinations.
- The Strip & Downtown Express - a rapid transit service that uses the StreetCar vehicles to connect travelers to Downtown Las Vegas, the Las Vegas Convention Center and major attractions along the Las Vegas Strip. Travelers on a tight schedule are encouraged to use this service as it provides faster service with fewer stops.
- The Westcliff Airport Express - provides transportation to and from McCarran International Airport, the Las Vegas Strip and downtown Las Vegas via transfers to the Deuce on the Strip or the Strip & Downtown Express.

RTC transit passes cost \$5 for a 2-Hour All Access Pass; \$7 for a 24-Hour All Access Pass and \$20 for a 3-Day All Access Pass. The 3-Day All Access Pass can be purchased online. These passes are good on the Westcliff Airport Express service, the Deuce on the Strip service, the Strip & Downtown Express service and on all residential routes. Travelers can visit [ridethestrip.com](http://ridethestrip.com) to access transit route maps, schedules and to purchase passes.
